





Half (\sim 2.463 million; 48.6%) of the 5.071 million resident of BC live in the southwest corner of the province in the Greater Vancouver Area (GVA). SAID patients (n = 149) came from all regions of BC and \sim 60% from the GVA (n = 94). BC Children's Hospital, which is the only tertiary pediatric health care centre in the province is situated in the GVA.
